 - ✓ Anton Cheklov says, “Life will sooner or later show its claws.” Describe a time in your life or in the life of someone you know when life has shown its “claws.”
 - ✓ Choose two important quotes from the novel. (Remember that quotes don’t have to be dialogue.) Copy them, including page numbers, and explain why you found them interesting. (Use MLA style for the page numbers, if you know how to do this.)
 - ✓ Tell me a little about yourself – academically and socially.
- ❖ Although it will be tempting to ask parents, older siblings, and friends for help, write this journal by yourself without any additional input from others.
- ❖ The journal is due on the first day of class. Bring *Claws* with you as we will be discussing the book.
